We would like to take this opportunity to offer you some additional guidance on requesting Buggies, Trolleys, Hire Clubs and Caddies.

Should you require any assistance with any of these areas, please follow the instruction below.

1. Golf Buggies (Carts)

Please be aware that **ALL** courses at St Andrews Links have a limited supply of golf buggies and they <u>should be</u> <u>requested in advance</u> - availability cannot be guaranteed and further information and booking conditions can be found on our website at <u>https://standrews.com/golf/playing-st-andrews/club-equipment-hire</u>

Old Course:

Available for golfers with a permanent condition of disability (i.e. holder of a Blue badge / a medical certificate from your medical practitioner certifying that under the Equality Act 2010 you have a substantial condition that affects your ability to play golf / a National Disabled Identification Card **or** an EU Disability card).

- Disability documentation should be provided at the time of booking.
- Hire fee is £40 (please note this charge may be subject to change)

New, Jubilee, Eden and Strathtyrum Courses:

Buggies may be reserved on all other courses by golfers over the age of 65 or with a medical certificate.

• Hire fee is £40 (please note this charge may be subject to change)

Due to the limited availability, ALL buggy requests must be received by 17.00 hrs on Sunday 31 March 2024.

NB: There is a limited supply of buggies - starting times will be arranged to accommodate this availability.

2. Manual and Electric Golf trolleys

Manual trolleys are available free of charge with the Starter at each course.

There is a limited supply of battery-powered trolleys available on the day (£20 hire fee) and should be booked in advance via <u>greig.dochard@standrews.com</u>. (please note this charge may be subject to change)

Old Course:

At present there are no restrictions on the use of Trolleys, however, this may change at short notice. Please keep up to date with any changes via our website at <u>www.standrews.com</u>

New, Jubilee, Eden and Strathtyrum Courses:

Trolleys are permitted at any time.

- Caddies will carry one bag and payment should be made, in cash, directly to the Caddie on completion of your round.
